



# Ice Fisheree Festival Details

The Marshall Lions present the 9<sup>th</sup> Annual Ice Fisheree Festival. Events for everyone and over \$15,000 in cash and prizes available! Jan 20-21, 2012

**Event Date & Location:** Friday, January 20 and Saturday, January 21, 2012 – at the American Legion Hall 279 American Legion Circle, Marshall, WI 53559 on the Maunasha River in Marshall, WI.

This Annual Marshall Lions event includes many family friendly and outdoor events for all to enjoy. Events include Candle-lit Ice Skating, , Snow Sculpting Contest, Ice Fishing Contest, Rabbit Hunt, Coyote Hunt, Broomball Tourney, Euchre Tournament, Texas Hold 'em Tourney and a DJ with Dancing to end the event. This event promises to be better than ever with more events, prizes, food and good times than ever before. Adults and children alike will have a great time. Here are the details by event:

## Ice Fishing Contest – \$200 Cash Prize for Largest Fish. Open to all waters in Dane, Jefferson & Columbia counties!!:

- **To Enter:** \$5 entry fee per person. Purchase entry tickets from any Lions member or during the event at the American Legion. Each entrant will get one free Outdoorsman's raffle ticket with entry.
- **Start and Stop:** Fishing starts at 6:00 am on the 21<sup>st</sup>
- **To Qualify:** Fishing open to all waters in Dane, Jefferson, & Columbia counties. Catch a fish in any of classes (Bass, Bluegill, Crappie, Walleye, Perch and Northern Pike). Fish must be caught on the 21<sup>st</sup> and registered whole. ALL DNR RULES APPLY. Judges decisions are final.
- **Registering your catch:** Registration is open from Noon to 2:30 pm on Sat, Jan 21<sup>st</sup> at the American Legion Hall in Marshall. Anglers fishing on the Maunasha River are encouraged to practice catch and release as only ONE fish per class, per participant can be registered for the contest.
- **How to win:** Adult and Kids (under 15) classes will be judged. Catch and register the largest fish by weight in each class by 2:30 pm on Saturday the 21<sup>st</sup>. Separate prizes and trophies will be awarded for each class. Tie breaker will be earliest time registered from 12 noon 10 am onward.
- **Prizes:** Adult prizes for two largest fish in each category - \$25 – 1<sup>st</sup>, \$20 – 2<sup>nd</sup>. Kids cash prizes - \$15 – 1<sup>st</sup>, \$10 – 2<sup>nd</sup> & \$5 – 3<sup>rd</sup> for the three largest legal fish in each category. Fish categories: Bass, Bluegill, Crappie, Walleye, Perch, Northern Pike and Catfish. \$200 Cash Prize and trophy for the largest fish caught based on length (any age group). Weight is tie breaker. Separate cash prizes & trophies for kids under 15. Prizes awarded at 3:00 pm.
- The first 120 kids 14 years old and under entered will receive a FREE fishing door prize. Kids will also receive on free entry to the \$100 kids only cash prize drawing (one for \$5 or six for \$20).

- **Team Sign-Up:** "Early bird" registration by Sunday January 8<sup>th</sup> and FINAL team registration is Thursday, Jan 19 by 10 pm. Registrations can be given to Kris Hellenbrand, dropped off at the Silver Fox Bar in Marshall or mailed to: Marshall Lions P.O. Box 655 Marshall, WI 53559. Team sign-ups not allowed the day of the event. Each registered hunter gets one FREE hunters gun raffle ticket. Early bird registrants (by Jan 8<sup>th</sup>) will get one addt'l Rabbit Hunters gun raffle ticket!!
- **Entry fee:** \$5 for one person team, \$10 for two person team.
- **Free Gun Raffle** – your rabbit hunt entry gets you one free hunter's gun raffle ticket.
- **Start and Stop:** Hunt starts at legal shooting hours on Friday, January 20<sup>th</sup>, 2012 and final check in is at 1:30 pm Saturday, January 21<sup>st</sup> at the American Legion Hall in Marshall.
- **To Qualify:** Rabbits must be harvested on either Friday or Saturday and registered the day they are harvested (2 rabbit limit for one-person team, 5 rabbit limit for two person team). Check in starts at 5 pm on Friday and ends at 1:30 pm Saturday. Same rabbits can be used in the one and two person contests. ALL OTHER DNR RULES APPLY.
- **How to win:** All qualifying teams will be placed into a drawing to determine first through (usually) 5th place but the number of places is based on the number of entries and teams that qualify.

- **To Qualify:** Coyotes must be harvested on either Friday, Jan 20 or Saturday, Jan 21 and must be registered the day they are harvested (2 coyote limit per team). Check in starts at 5 pm on Friday and ends at 1:30 pm Saturday. ALL OTHER DNR RULES APPLY.
- **How to win:** All qualifying teams will be placed into a drawing to determine the places. Number of places is based on the number of entries and teams that qualify.
- **Prizes:** Cash payouts to be determined based on size of registration and number of qualifying teams or those with the most coyotes (non-limit).

- **Start and Stop:** Teams are to check in on the ice behind the American Legion in Marshall at 9:45 am with the first game starting at 9 am, highlighted by the Marshall Lions vs. Marshall Fire Dept exhibition at high Noon.
- **What to bring:** Brooms and protective gear. Some brooms and balls will be provided. It is strongly recommended that you bring protective equipment such as shin guards, a helmet, heavy gloves and any other safety gear that you deem fit. Metal cleats or shoes otherwise outfitted with metal traction devices cannot be worn. **\*\*NO PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT WILL BE PROVIDED – BRING YOUR OWN!\*\***
