2023 Marshall Lions Ice Fisheree Rules

(DNR free fishing weekend – no license required)

<u>Ice Fisheree Rules</u>: Fishing is from 6:00am until 2:30pm on January 21, 2023 at Fireman's Park only. Shelter doors will open at 5:30am for registration by Lion Mike Wildman. Entry fee is the purchase of at least one raffle ticket. Prizes to be awarded at 3:00pm inside the heated shelter. As always, all DNR rules apply.

- 5 categories this year: Crappie, Bluegill, Bass, Northern, and Walleye
- Same payout for kids 14 and under as well as adults. The first 40 kids will receive
 a door prize when they check into the fishing registration table.
- 1st and 2nd place trophies for the kids 14 and under
- Payout is \$50 for 1st place and \$25 for second place
- \$100 kids drawing is at 2:30pm. Kids do not need to purchase a ticket to enter Fisheree.
- Adults must purchase a gun or cash raffle ticket to enter Fisheree.
- 1 fish entered per category per person. If they catch a bigger fish, you can replace the smaller one brought in earlier.

Postal scale will be used on pan fish. When registering fish, the contestant needs to bring the fish to the registration table. First, we go by weight, then by length. In the event of a tie, we will use the earliest fish registered.

All prizes awarded will be handed out at the Fisheree, by check or mailed if winners are not present.

The 1st tagged Bass caught on January 21, 2023 at Fireman's Park between 6:00am and 2:30pm will be awarded \$1000.00. The person catching the fish needs to report it to the Fisheree registration table as soon as possible.
